Beauty from Ashes

Have you ever thought about the plight of millions of women around the world who are being sexually exploited, but felt completely helpless as to how you could make a difference? With just one purchase of jewellery you can change a life. Many women in Nepal suffer from sexual exploitation. Each year, 5,000 to 12,000 women are trafficked out of Nepal to India, making Nepal the largest 'sending country' for human trafficking in India. The name 'Beauty from Ashes' is taken from Isaiah 61:1-3, 'to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes.' This verse summaries the mission of Beauty from Ashes, as not only does it 'serve as a viable employment option for women who have come out of prostitution,' it also 'seeks to holistically aid in their healing by providing an atmosphere in which Jesus Christ's truth and love transforms lives.'

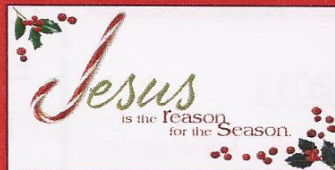


Ladies' Big Breakfast
